Gregg Appraisal District Mails Annual Notice of Appraised Value Forms

Gregg County – The Gregg County Appraisal District is in the process of mailing annual Notice of Appraised Value forms to property owners. These forms are sent on all properties receiving a change in value. Review your appraisal notice and note the deadline date for the filing of your protest. Texas law is restrictive regarding changes to property values after the protest deadline. Review all information contained in the notice including ownership, value and any exemptions for which you may be qualified. If you have any questions or concerns call the appraisal district as soon as possible. Most matters are resolved with an informal meeting, either by phone or in person, with a GCAD staff member.

If you prefer to file a formal protest, GCAD'S website, www.gcad.org contains forms and information to assist you in filing and presenting a protest before the Appraisal Review Board. On our website you will find the Comptroller's publication, "Property Taxpayer Remedies" and video "How to Present Your Case at an Appraisal Review Board Hearing" which explains this process in detail. Owners of residential property will also find instructions for E-file protest accompanying their Notice of Appraised Value.
