## New Deadlines for Business Personal Property Filings

**IMPORTANT:** Changes now require that renditions and property reports are due to the Gregg County Appraisal District *on or before April 15th* of each tax year. On written request by the property owner, the Chief Appraiser shall extend the deadline for filing a rendition statement or property report to May 15<sup>th</sup>, if requested by the original deadline date of April 15th. The Chief Appraiser may further extend the deadline an additional 15 days to May 30<sup>th</sup> for good cause shown in writing by the property owner, if filed by the extended deadline date of May 15th. If a business fails to render or if the rendition is turned in after the deadline date, there will be a 10% penalty on the property owner's tax bill for the current year.
