Closed sessions may include Sec. 551.071 (Consultation with attorney regarding pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or any matter on which the attorney has a duty to advise the Board under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct), Sec. 551.072 (Deliberations regarding real property), Sec. 551.074 (Personnel matters to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee, or to hear a complaint or charge against a public officer or employee), Sec. 551.076 (Deliberations regarding security devices), or any other provision under the Open Meetings Act which would legally apply. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed meeting. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.

Notice: The District has on prior agendas noted which items might be discussed in a closed session. The law does not require the District to identify which agenda items might be subject to a closed session and the District will no longer make that distinction.
